Feature Cake: Lemon Sour Cream Butter Cake.

125grms butter, 1cup castor sugar, vanilla, 3 eggs, 1cup plain Flour 1/4 cup Self Raising Flour 1/3 cup sour cream 2 teaspoons finely grated lemon rind.

Cream butter, sugar, vanilla and lemon rind add eggs one at a time beating well. Add flour then sour cream. Combine well. Pour into a loaf tin which has been lined with baking paper. Cook in a moderate oven for about 50 minutes. Cool them ice with lemon icing. Ray Farrell Memorial prize. 1st \$12 2nd \$8 3rd \$5.
