(b) Wire not permitted in Dahlias.
(c) Dahlias over 160mm - One (1) per vase unit.
(d) Dahlias under 160mm - Three (3) per vase unit.
(e) Unless otherwise stated, Dahlias must have stalk \& stem and to be $300 \mathrm{~mm}(12 \mathrm{in})$ in overall length.

Medium to be over 160 mm and under 210 mm in diameter.
