DAHLIA CLASSES

- (a) Dahlias will be judged under Dahlia Society standards.
- (b) Wire not permitted in Dahlias.
- (c) Dahlias over 160mm - One (1) per vase unit.
- (d) Dahlias under 160mm - Three (3) per vase unit.
- (e) Unless otherwise stated, Dahlias must have stalk & stem and to be 300mm(12in) in overall length.

FORMAL DECORATIVE SECTIONS

Large to be over 210mm and under 260mm in diameter.
Medium to be over 160mm and under 210mm in diameter.
Small to be over 120mm and under 160mm in diameter.
Miniature to over 90mm and under 120mm diameter.

CACTUS DAHLIA

Large to be 210mm and over.
Medium to be over 160mm and under 210mm in diameter.
Small to be over 120mm and under 160mm in diameter.
Miniature to be over 90mm and under 120mm in diameter.

EXHIBITION CACTUS DAHLIA

Large Exhibition Cactus Dahlia to be not less than 160mm.
Small Exhibition Cactus Dahlia to be 120mm and not more than 160mm in diameter.

D = Distinct (means that each unit must be different from the other)
NND = Not Necessarily Distinct.
